

Rules and Regulations

The Catholic Community of Moriah Cemetery
St. Patrick's Cemetery
St. Peter & St. Paul Cemetery

- All Lots in each cemetery mentioned above have to be under perpetual care and are charged accordingly. Contact the office for costs regarding the above mentioned cemeteries.

A deposit of 50% is required for the total purchase on the cemetery lot.

- No monument, memorial, footstone or cornerstone can be placed on lot until all charges are paid.
- Only one monument or memorial is permitted on any one lot with the exceptions of all footmarkers which are to be flush with the ground when installed.
- Annual flowers are *not permitted* to be planted in the ground. Live flowers must be placed in concrete or appropriate urns. Plant Hangers are allowed but must be placed near the foundation of the monument. To plant shrubs and trees you must contact our cemetery caretaker. The owner assumes the care of the flowers and plants by keeping grass trimmed in that area thus insuring that they do not obstruct the work of the cemetery employees.
- Artificial flowers and wreaths are *not permitted* to be planted in the ground at any time during the year with the exception from Memorial Day until July 1. Artificial flowers are *allowed* to be attached on top of the stone in an appropriate container. Toys, metal signs or ornaments, vases, solar lights and crockery are *not permitted*.

- **The certificate of purchase (or deed/easement) must be shown whenever one requests a grave to be opened. Such a request must be made by the Lot owner, his/her representative or responsible agent.**
- **No burial shall be allowed in any Lot against which there shall appear overdue charges of any kind.**
- **All interments must conform strictly to the Laws, usages and discipline of the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Ogdensburg.**
- **All cemetery work (grading and care of Lots, digging of graves, monument foundations, etc.) must be done by cemetery employees.**
- **All dues must be paid at the office of the cemetery at St. Patrick's Parish Office at 12 St. Patrick's Place, Port Henry, NY 12974.**
- **Vaults are required for all burials.**
